Electoral Roll Members attending the Virtual AGM via live audio-visual webcast are required to put on their video. Electoral Roll Members in the same household sharing the same device are required to sit visibly before the camera. This is to allow us to track attendance more accurately.

Electoral Roll Members who are attending via live audioonly stream are required to verify their identities to the Administrator by providing the last 4 digits of their NRIC numbers.

The Virtual AGM will be open from 2.30 p.m. for Electoral Roll Members to enter the webinar. Electoral Roll Members are encouraged to request admittance into the Virtual AGM at least 15 minutes before the commencement of the Virtual AGM to facilitate Electoral Roll Member identification and to prevent delays to the start of the Virtual AGM.
