run to the parish, diocese-wide prayer for the parish and a whole lot of buzz on social media for this one featured parish.





Anglican Preschool Services













Diocesan Education Month: Anglican Preschool Services (APS)

APS was set up by the Anglican Diocese of Singapore to be a bridge between the Church and community through holistic preschool education, infused with Christian values. To date, APS operates 18 Christian preschools, sowing seeds & transforming lives. You can support APS by (a) enrolling your child in an APS preschool; (b) signing up as a staff or volunteer; (c) praying for APS; and (d) giving financially.

Responding to the demand for childcare, APS needs to convert all its kindergartens to childcare centres. The conversion will cost \$5.9M over two years. About 45% of this has been secured, leaving about \$3M yet to be raised. Do prayerfully consider partnering APS in this conversion endeavour. You may scan the QR code for General Fund for this purpose. Every bit counts.
