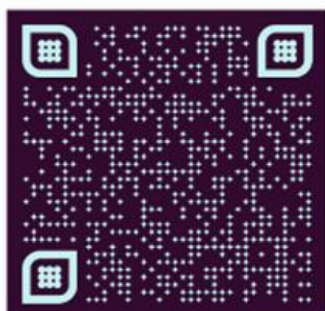

THE RT REVD DR TITUS CHUNG
ARCHBISHOP-ELECT
OF THE CHURCH OF THE PROVINCE OF SOUTH EAST ASIA



At the recent Extraordinary Provincial Synod, our Diocesan Bishop, the Right Reverend Dr Titus Chung has been elected the next Archbishop of the Church of the Province of South East Asia. In February 2024, he will succeed the Most Reverend Datuk Melter Jiki Tais, who would have served as Archbishop of the Province for 4 years.

The Installation Service of the 7th Archbishop of The Province of South East Asia will be set in early 2024 at St Andrew's Cathedral. Further details will be provided in due course.

Let us keep Archbishop-Elect Dr Titus Chung and his family in prayer as he prepares to take on this heavy responsibility.
