Notice is hereby given that the 2024 Annual General Meeting of the Church of the Good Shepherd (English Congregation) will be held on **28 April 2024 (Sunday), 12.15pm**, at 2 Dundee Road, the Sanctuary at Level 2

Electoral Roll (ER) Members

The Electoral Roll determines those who are eligible to either vote or be elected at the Annual General Meeting onto the ECC.

Baptised members, who are at least 17 years of age, confirmed in the Anglican Church, and regularly attending Service and partaking Holy Communion in the Church, are eligible to be on the Electoral Roll.

Nomination of Office Bearers

The upcoming AGM will elect the People's Warden and eight (8) members of the English Congregation Council "the ECC"

Candidates for election to membership of the ECC shall be on the Electoral Roll of the parish and must be nominated by writing from one member and seconded by another, subject to prior consent to nomination by the candidate.

If you have transferred to Good Shepherd from another church in this Diocese, you should apply for Membership Transfer and also apply to be on the Electoral Roll (ER).

You must complete your ER application by 31 March 2024, in order for you to be eligible to vote at the AGM 2024.
